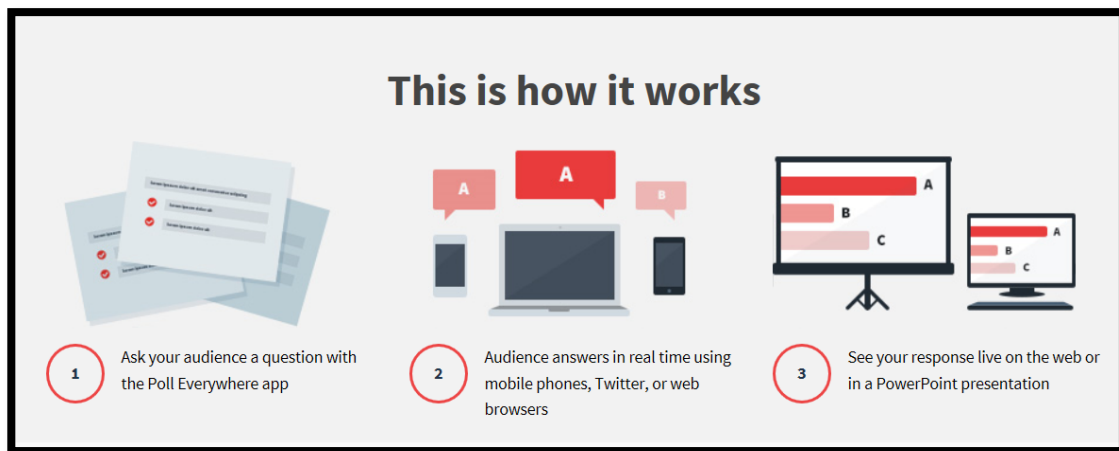




Poll Everywhere

Poll Everywhere is an application that allows audiences to use smart devices or computers to reply to polls. Check it out at www.polleverywhere.com and set up your FREE account!



Step by Step

STEP 1: YOU ASK A QUESTION

Use the easy poll creator to ask your questions.

Type your question into the poll creator, select the kind of poll you want to make, and press “create.” That’s it. Your poll is ready to share with students! All the polls you create will appear on your My Polls page for as long as you care to keep them there - and as long as you have an account.

Choose the type of question you want.

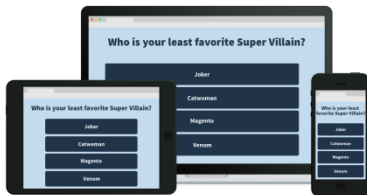
STEP 2: YOUR STUDENTS RESPOND

Smart Device Texting

Smart phones OR dumb phones... anyone who can text can contribute to your poll. The poll automatically shows the texting instructions for the service area associated with your account. Start your poll and watch the votes roll in.



Web voting



The easiest, most elegant way to vote is through the web interface. Anyone who has a web browser can participate. You control which poll your audience sees by “pushing” it to their individual devices. They visit your PollEv voting page at PollEv.com/yourname, the poll appears, and they click.

STEP 3: REAL TIME, LIVE RESULTS

You created polls, your audience voted, and now... the moment of excitement when you see the live results flash on the wall. There’s nothing like a chart of bouncing bars or a live updating word cloud to fire up a crowd!

From any Web browser

The quickest and easiest way to display your results is directly from the website. Once you enable fullscreen mode, your browser and all the browser buttons are hidden so the only thing your audience sees is their responses in all their glory.

In your PowerPoint

You can present your polls as a seamless part of your PowerPoint. Flip on through and instead of another flat picture, your audience sees your slide come alive with real time poll results. You just need to download the PollEv Presenter app.



Poll Everywhere in the Classroom: Ideas for YOU!

1. Check for Understanding:
 - a. Use it at the end of a lesson or unit to see the muddiest point. This would be used as an exit slip to see if your students “got it” or “missed the boat”.
2. Bell Ringer:
 - a. Do Now! Activity when students enter class (ex: What did you do this weekend? How do you feel about the upcoming test?).
3. Classroom Decisions:
 - a. Sometimes students like to be in control and have a voice in what they do. Give them choices and let them choose the next topic of discussion, what you could do on a “work day”, what book to read next, etc.
4. Do you have any Questions?:
 - a. Here come the blank stares - nobody ever has any questions, but then you know that someone doesn't get it. Allow the students to respond and the students will not know who had the question.

2. Sign up for a free account and make sure you say that you are a k-12 educator
3. You can start creating your first poll right away or cancel the video and explore the site.
